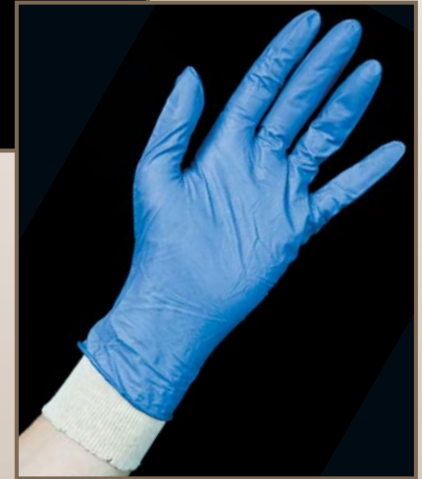


GloveMate™ cotton liners are designed to be worn under your latex and synthetic gloves to offer the following benefits.

- Hands stay cool and comfortable. GloveMate™ allows perspiration to evaporate by exposing the perspiration to air and channeling it between the raised rib knitting.
- GloveMate™ protects against bacterial skin infections, including dermatitis, and open pore skin irritations. GloveMate™ inhibits skin contact with the outer glove reducing exposure to latex proteins.
- GloveMate™ is constructed of 100% undyed cotton and keeps hands dry for repetitive glove donning.
- GloveMate™ raised ribbed knitting creates thermal air channels between the users hand and the outer glove. This thermal air space works as a heat transfer system allowing air to circulate beneath the outer glove, which stabilizes hand temperature when exposed to heat or cold.



Worn as glove underwear, GloveMate helps keep hands cool, dry and comfortable, while protecting against skin irritations.

FirstLine Recommended Hand Care Regime

Follow this simple hand hygiene regime to assist in the repair and healing of compromised hands or to assist in the prevention of skin degradation which can lead to sensitization.

SOAPS

- **NO** anti-bacterial hand soaps or quick-dry hand sanitizers off shift. Minimize use of these products on shift to when exposure is prevalent.
- **Minimize** use of soaps and sanitizers whose primary ingredient is alcohol.
- **NO** soaps that contain the ingredient THIMEROSOL.
- **DO** use Aveeno or equivalent oatmeal-based soap off shift to reduce stripping oil from hands.

LOTIONS

- **NO** Lanolin or Aloe-based lotions on or off shift.
- **DO** use Aveeno or equivalent oatmeal-based lotion off shift to promote healing.
- **Do use Bio-Safe** Skin Protectant on and off shift, or as necessary, to repair the hands.

GLOVES

- **DO** use FirstLine gloves or comparable gloves identified to be low in accelerators, e.g. thiurams, carbamates and mercaptobenzothiazoles, known to cause irritation.

GLOVE LINERS

- **DO** use when on shift. Change when the liner becomes "moist" with perspiration.

SKINS NATURAL OILS

- The skin's natural oils are critical in preventing a career glove wearer from developing irritant contact dermatitis or an allergic reaction. Chronic hand washing with alcohol-based soaps strip the skin of their own natural oils, creating direct pathways for irritants or allergens to enter the system, which dramatically increases the chance of becoming sensitized.
